Students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better in courses used to fulfill requirements for the Certificate.

The student's grade point average (gpa) is computed by dividing grade points earned by the number of credit hours attempted. Grades P and S do not carry grade points, and the credit hours are not calculated into the gpa. Credits attempted for F grades are calculated into the gpa.
